**Description of different Packages**

***Traditional Service***

A traditional service consists of preparing the remains, that is, its embalming, followed later by visitation. Visitations may be one or two days more from the ceremony's day, and can be with open or closed casket, in private or not. After visitation, a ceremony in a place of worship, in a chapel or hall, will take place and the remains will then be interred, cremated or entombed. Should the remains be cremated, the family will have the option of renting or purchasing a casket. In this type of service, the funeral home staff coordinates all the funeral process services and is present at each step, while the family needs to make only a single stop, if desired.



### *Modified Traditional Service*



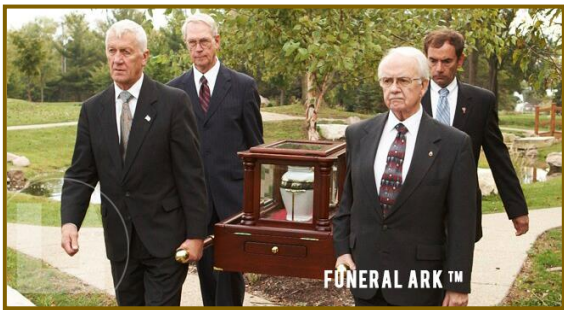
A modified traditional service consists of preparing the remains, that is, its embalming, followed by a ceremony in a place of worship, chapel or hall, but without prior visitation. The family will generally greet friends and relatives for thirty to sixty minutes at the place of ceremony and then the remains will be brought in. Subsequently, the remains will be interred, cremated or entombed. Should the remains be cremated, the family will have the option of renting or purchasing a casket. In this type of service, the funeral home staff coordinates all the funeral process services and is present at each step, while the family needs to make only a single stop, if desired.

### *Modified Direct Disposition with a Service*

For this type of service, the remains are prepared, that is, embalmed, followed by private visitation. Relatives and friends come by invitation for a period of two hours on average, and no announcement is made as to visitation. After visitation, everyone goes home and cremation of the remains takes place afterwards. A ceremony, during which the cremated remains are present, is held in a place of worship, chapel or hall several days later. The family may greet friends and relatives thirty to sixty minutes before the ceremony at the place where the ceremony is held or where they wish. They may also receive condolences at the funeral home for a



longer time and with amenities that are not necessarily found elsewhere. If so, after condolences everyone leaves the funeral home in procession to go to the place where the ceremony will be held. It can also be a mix of using the funeral home to greet friends and relatives on the day prior to the day of Service and using the facilities where the Service is going to be held on the day of the Service to receive condolences. In addition, two other options are offered to the family. Most families opt to use the funeral ark, being a platform on which the funeral urn is placed, allowing flowers to be laid on supports at either end and fitted with handles on either side. Four family members act as bearers. If



the family receives condolences at the place where the ceremony is held, the ark may have already been placed there when the family arrives or we can enter with it just before the beginning of the ceremony. In this way the clergy will receive us as he would for the remains. If an ark is not opted for, the urn will be placed on a table for the ceremony. In this type of service, the funeral home staff coordinates all the funeral process services and is present at each step, while the family needs to make only a single stop, if desired.

### *Direct Disposition with a Service*



For this type of service, the remains are cremated without the ceremony of prior private or public visitations taking place. A ceremony, during which the cremated remains are present, takes place in a place of worship, chapel or hall several days later. The family may receive condolences thirty to sixty minutes before the ceremony at the place where the ceremony is held or where they wish, and they may also receive condolences at the funeral home for a longer time and with amenities that are not found elsewhere. If so, after condolences everyone leaves the funeral home in procession to go to the place where the ceremony will be held. It can also be a mix of using the funeral home to greet friends and relatives on the day prior to the day of Service and using the facilities where the Service is going to be held on the

day of the Service to receive condolences. In addition, two other options are offered to the family. Most families opt to use the funeral ark because it is a platform on which the funeral urn is placed, allowing flowers to be laid on supports at either end and fitted with handles on either side. Four family members act as bearers. If the family receives condolences at the place where the ceremony is held, the ark may be placed there when the family arrives or we can enter with it just before the beginning of the ceremony. In this way the clergy will receive us as he would for the remains. If an ark is not opted for, the urn will be placed on a table for the ceremony. In this type of service, the funeral home staff can coordinate all the funeral process services and is present at each step, while the family needs to make only a single stop, if desired.

### *Minimum Service*

For this type of service, the remains are cremated or interred without prior private or public visitations taking place. The funeral home staff only deals with legal tasks and cremation or interment of the remains, and recovery of the cremated remains from the crematorium, if required. Since we are only dealing with the minimum, the family needs to take care of formalities in connection with the clergy, cemetery, newspaper, etc. In addition, they must look after organization of the ceremony and presentation of the ashes, if required, at the place of final disposal.

The above packages explain you different options available. Note however that we can provide you personalized services that meet the needs of your family. We thank you to show us your confidence in our team and our establishment.

## **Disbursements**

Disbursements are items that may be arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf, by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that may be identified as disbursements.

Coroner's fee – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Clergy honorarium – this is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases the amount is set by the clergy, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

Choir/Signer/Musician – this is an amount paid to a person or to a group for their music services during a Ceremony/Service. The amount is set by each individual or group.

Newspaper notices – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or other media outlets.

Municipal death registration fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

Hall Rental – this is a fee charged by either a municipality or any other organization that owns a hall for the use of a hall for either a visitation period or a gathering after a Service.

## **Payment, financing and funding**

Here are the payment, funding and financing options we offer to our clients.

### **Payment**

Unless otherwise specified, payment is due within 30 days of signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash and/or cheque. Beyond the allotted time, interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5% per month, which is equivalent to 18% per annum (APR).

If you are prepaying for services or supplies, pre-authorized chequing is also available.

### **Financing**

No financing plan is available for funeral services and/or supplies provided at need. As for funeral arrangements paid in advance, we offer various financing plans for different needs. Please inquire to one of our funeral directors to get more information.

### **Funding**

If you want to prepay services and/or supplies, we offer a convenient option for capitalization. If the contract is paid in full in accordance with the terms of payment, the payment required under the contract, plus the income earned, will be applied to the cost of the services, supplies, disbursements and applicable taxes at the time of death, the effective price list being used to calculate the amount owed. If the payment plus income earned is less than the cost of the services, supplies, disbursements and applicable taxes, no further payment will be required. If it is greater, a cheque equal to the excess of funds will be issued.

Trust: You may pay the money directly to us and we will place it in trust, where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.

For either people in need or eligible people, we will assist you into verifying the availability of either subsidies (such as Last Post or Social Services) or Death Benefits (such as Canada Pension Plan, Quebec Pension Plan or the Automobile Insurance).
